

# Get DTV Ready In Three Steps



## Apply for a **\$40 Coupon** Today

By June 12, 2009, if you use “rabbit ears” or a rooftop antenna, you must take action or your TV picture — clear or snowy — will be gone. A TV converter box is one option to keep your analog television working. The Federal government is offering all U.S. households up to two **\$40 coupons** to help pay for the cost of TV converter boxes. Supplies are limited.

### APPLY



**Apply for your free \$40 coupon today.** The coupon can be used toward the purchase of a TV converter box. To apply, go to [www.DTV2009.gov](http://www.DTV2009.gov) or call 1-888-DTV-2009 (1-888-388-2009). Deaf or hard of hearing callers may dial 1-877-530-2634 (TTY).

### BUY



**Buy a converter box as soon as your coupon comes in the mail.** Coupons expire 90 days after they are mailed. A list of retailers will come in the envelope with your coupons.

### TRY



**Hook-up your converter box to your TV as soon as you get it home.** You can start watching digital TV today. For help with set up or using the converter box, call 1-888-CALL-FCC (voice) or 1-888-TELL-FCC (TTY) or visit [www.dtv.gov](http://www.dtv.gov).
